

Lesson Nine - Quick View

	ACTIVITY	TIME	OBJECTIVE	ACTION
1	Greetings	2 min	Set the tone for your class	Championeers! Roll Call.
2	Review	3 min	Review Music	Slowly address any tricky spots from last week without the music. Repeat 2-3 times then sing and dance without music. Add music.
3	Sing & Swing	4 min	To Know You Care	Listen to song while keeping a steady beat. Learn chorus lyrics by call and response. Learn movements.
4	Video: Lesson #9	5 min	Gator Danger	Watch the STEM lesson that demonstrates how the properties of wicking can transfer the contents of one cup to another.
5	Opt. Activity	3 min	Choice Cards	Examples of breaking and entering unhealthy agreements.
6	Sing & Swing	5 min	To Know You Care	Very slow. Fix any mistakes. Then faster until at tempo. Add music.
7	Video: Episode #9	4 min	Pirate Pledges	Championeers! Adventure Theater
8	Champ Chat	3 min	Review & Reinforce	All Songs. Review lesson.
9	Leadership Challenge	1 min	Guard Your Agreements & avoid Gator D-Anger	Leaders guard what they listen to and avoid entering into unhealthy agreements.

Lesson #9 Details

1. Greetings

Championeers! Roll Call.

2. Review

Quick run-through of all songs so far. Practice perfection.



3. Sing & Swing To Know You Care

- Listen song while keeping a steady beat.
- Teach the chorus lyrics by call and response.
- Listen again, and have students sing along with the chorus.
- Add movements with the chorus lyrics, then add music.





4. Video Lesson #9 Gator D-Anger

Watch the STEM lesson. Discuss how easy it is to pick-up the offenses and anger of those around us.

5. Optional Activity Rewrite Wrongs

Choice Cards provide examples of breaking and entering unhealthy agreements.



6. Sing & Swing Buccaneers We Are

 Practice and review lyrics and movements very slow at first, to fix any mistakes, then speed up to full speed.
 Don't add music until you've ran through it at least two times--then add music.

- Learn verse lyrics.
- Add music. Sing along with all lyrics and do movements for chorus.
- Learn movements for verse.
- When the music starts, count to two before starting the first movement (this is how students know when to start).
- Finish all movements for verse, add music.



7. Video: Episode #9 Pirate Pledges

Chief Bo Guama rescue the castaways and tell them the story of Captain Three Beards father. Pete and the castaways are sad and angry. The determine to find the pirates and seek revenge.

8. Champ Chat Review

- Review any/all of the songs.
- Review STEM video, Rewrite Wrongs
- Make a big deal about the next part of the story! KEEP IT A SECRET AND BUILD SUSPENSE!
