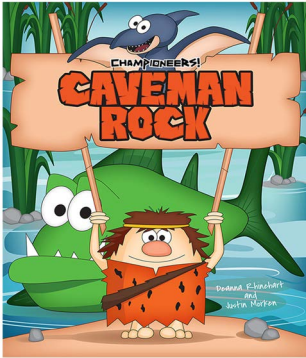


IS YOUR SCHOOL ELIGIBLE?



Champions! ESE System Definition and Purpose

Champions! is an anti-bullying, emotional safety education system that develops emotionally safe campuses for students and staff through campus culture development.

Scope of Grant

Champions! provides ESE Grants of up to \$50,000 in training and resources to eligible Lead Schools to participate in research on the impact of emotional safety education for the prevention and intervention of critical youth issues.

Implementation Requirements

Champions! is a school-wide implementation system that addresses the root causes of issues, not just the symptoms, with the Seven Essential Elements required to develop an emotionally safe campus culture. Themed, units serve as an all-in-one solution to integrate PBIS, MTSS, RTI, STEM, Civics, Character, SEL, Leadership, The Arts, ACE, Resiliency Training, and PSEL/NELP Standards into a single, unified, strategic plan integrated into the system. Since music holds the rare ability to promote development of neural pathways between IQ and EQ, this fun-filled, tool-rich production is taught in music class utilizing a multi-disciplinary approach for the deployment of the Seven Essentials through IQ-EQ music emulsification. The weekly KEY lesson is reinforced in homerooms through STEM leadership challenges and discussions, and carried throughout the school so students receive one message, with many layers, connecting cause and effect reasoning for increased academic and social problem-solving skills. Minimum ESE Grant Eligibility Requirements:

- Participation in the Champions! ESE research project as a Lead School for a minimum of two unit cycles.
- An earnest and wholehearted implementation of the Champions! system.
- Principal's full support and involvement.
- A designated ESE campus coordinator.
- Music teacher's enthusiastic willingness to lead the school-wide ESE production as one unit of his/her curriculum.
- A Lead Team consisting of grade-level leads, ESE Coordinator, PBIS/SEL coordinators, principal, music teacher, and specialists.
- ESE training completed by all certified staff.
- Signed Letter of Commitment and Grand Rights Performance License Agreement.
