#### In a Nutshell

Review/finish 15 Men on a Dead Man's Chest. Listen to When You're a Pirate and learn chorus lyrics. Scatter Brains Lesson. Learn movements to When You're a Pirate chorus, then add music. Learn When You're a Pirate verse lyric. Add movements. Add music. Review songs with music and movements.



### Lesson Two - Quick View

	ACTIVITY	TIME	OBJECTIVE	ACTION
1	Greetings	2 min	Set the tone for your class	Championeers! Roll Call.
2	Review	3 min	Review 15 Men on a Dead Man's Chest	Slowly address any tricky spots from last week without the music. Repeat 2-3 times then sing and dance without music. Add music.
3	Sing & Swing	4 min	When You're a Pirate	Listen to song, When You're a Pirate. while keeping a steady beat. Learn chorus lyrics by call and response. Learn movements.
4	Video: Lesson #2	5 min	Scatter Brains	Discussion: How our brain functions without a goal. Watch Scatter Brains.
5	Opt. Activity	3 min	Pirate Jokes	Enjoy some pirate jokes and discuss the optional chore chart. You can make a chore chart for your class.
6	Sing & Swing	5 min	Reinforce When You're a Pirate	Very slow. Fix any mistakes. Then faster until at tempo. Add music.
7	Video: Episode #2	4 min	In Search of Treasure	Championeers! Adventure Theater Circle.
8	Champ Chat	3 min	Review & Reinforce	15 Men on a Dead Man's Chest and When You're a Pirate. Review lesson.
9	Leadership Challenge	1 min	Reinforce The Power of Goals	Leaders love to search for life's treasures by making goals they can reach and aspire to. Make your own treasure maps (goals). Make one for your classroom.

#### Lesson #2 Details

#### 1. Greetings

Championeers! Roll Call then immediately go into review without explanation. Just go right into it with high energy. Show students what to do, don't tell.

#### 2. Review

15 Men on a Dead Man's Chest. Review lyrics, finish learning all movements if needed.



### 3. Sing & Swing When You're a Pirate

- Listen to When You're a Pirate, while keeping a steady beat.
- Ask students if they know what a pirate is, then give a quick overview.
- Teach the chorus lyrics by call and response.
- Listen again, and have students sing along with the chorus.
- Add movements with the chorus lyrics, then add music.



## 4. Video Lesson #2 Scatter Brains

Discuss how goals attract either positive or negative thoughts.

# Optional ActivityChore Chart/Treasure Map

A download link to a chore chart has been included in your parent notes. Discuss how chore charts help your brain reach goals. Consider making a treasure map to reach a classroom goal.

### 6. Sing & Swing When You're a Pirate

- Practice and review lyrics and movements to
   When You're a Pirate. Very slow at first, to fix any mistakes, then speed up to full
  - to fix any mistakes, then speed up to full speed. Don't add music until you've ran through it at least two times--then add music.
- Learn verse lyrics.
- Add music. Sing along with all lyrics and do movements for chorus.
- Learn movements for verse.
- When the music starts, count to two before starting the first movement (this is how students know when to start).
- Finish all movements for verse, add music.



## 7. Video: Episode #2 In Search of Treasure

Captain Three Beards finds fairy cove. Remember to make a really big deal out of the cliff hangers!

#### 8. Champ Chat Review

- Review 15 Men on a Dead Man's Chest and When You're a Pirate.
- Review Scatter Brains
- Make a big deal about the next part of the story! KEEP IT A SECRET AND BUILD SUSPENSE!
- Remind students to keep a chore chart.



#### 9. Leadership Challenge: Set Goals

Choose one goal to accomplish during Pete and the Pirates. Write it down, make it clear, what are the steps you'll take to accomplish your goal.

BONUS: Turn your goal into a treasure map with your goal as the treasure and all the smaller steps as mini-goals.
